SPECIAL TRANSPORTATION

Policy Statement

Cypress County recognizes the need to provide subsidized transportation for residents with special needs. The Family and Community Support Services (FCSS) Board has determined that reasonable travel is from the resident's home into the City of Medicine Hat/Town of Redcliff to obtain services and return home.

Procedures

- a) Residents with special needs must apply in writing, using the form set out in this policy.
- b) A letter of support may be requested from a social services agency to confirm the need for the service.
- c) Once approved, the resident must contact Deluxe Central Taxi when transportation is needed.
- d) The resident must pay 50% of the fare each time the service is used.
- e) The County will pay the remaining 50% upon invoice from Deluxe Central Taxi.
- f) Travel within the City/Town is not cost-shared.
- g) In unique circumstances, upon approval of the FCSS Board, payment of 50% of private vehicle km may be paid in lieu of the taxi service. The maximum per km rate allowed will be the Councillor rate, as stated in Policy ADM 4 Travel and Subsistence. Funds can only be paid to a third party agency; they cannot be paid to a resident's partner, family member, other relative or friend.
