

CYPRESS COUNTY

PUBLIC NOTICE

Cypress County has had requests from Farmers / Ranchers to cost share putting gravel in the ruts of certain unmaintained road allowances. It is believed that putting down gravel will provide a long term driveable access road to fields or pastures. The County would contribute to the request on a 50 / 50 cost shared basis. The County is willing to participate on a pilot project basis and reserves the right to review the program depending on demand.

Excerpt from Policy R 9:

“Ratepayers may apply to the County to gravel the ruts of grassed-in road allowances (prairie trails). Upon payment of 50% of the estimated cost of the project, the Public Works Supervisor may approve the project for a maximum distance of 3.2 km (2 miles) per ratepayer per year on a first come first served basis. Industrial companies (eg. oil and gas) are not eligible for this program.”
