

Cypress County Fire Ban Levels

Advisory

An Advisory is put on when fire conditions warrant public notification of an impending Fire Ban. The Advisory will identify specific areas or the entire County. Details such as weather conditions that could extend or remove the Advisory and the date/time for any proposed Fire Ban will be included.

Level I

Permitted burning in Cypress County is banned due to dry/windy conditions. All outstanding fire permits are suspended until further notice.

The exemptions to this fire ban are listed as follows:

- . Internal household fire places
- . Incinerators (for farm and acreage use)
- . Regulated burning barrels
- . Camp stoves
- . Solid fuel barbecues (charcoal briquettes)
- . Liquid fuel barbecues (propane and natural gas)
- . Recreational camp fires (approved burn pit 24” in diameter or less)
- . Chimeneas
- . Fires contained within approved facilities and appliances in designated camping and recreational areas

Level II

Permitted burning in Cypress County is banned due to dry/windy conditions. All outstanding fire permits are suspended until further notice.

This fire ban includes:

- . Incinerators (for farm and acreage use)
- . Solid fuel barbecues (charcoal briquettes)
- . Recreational camp fires (approved burn pit 24” in diameter or less)

- . Chimeneas
- . Fires contained within approved facilities and appliances in designated camping and recreational areas

The exemptions to this fire ban are listed as follows:

- . Internal household fire places
- . Regulated burning barrels
- . Camp stoves
- . Liquid fuel barbecues (propane and natural gas)

Level III

Permitted burning in Cypress County is banned due to dry/windy conditions. All outstanding fire permits are suspended until further notice.

This fire ban includes:

- . Incinerators (for farm and acreage use)
- . Regulated burning barrels
- . Camp stoves
- . Solid fuel barbecues (charcoal briquettes)
- . Recreational camp fires (approved burn pit 24” in diameter or less)
