You can work independently, take direction, show initiative, and enjoy working in all weather conditions. Compensation for the position is based on education & experience. This full-time, **temporary** position works **40 hours per week**, however, there may be a requirement for overtime.

Required qualification include the following:

- Successful completion of Grade 12 or equivalent (GED)
- A valid Alberta Class 5 motor vehicle operator's license with acceptable driving record is a requirement for a Municipal Worker II.
- A valid Alberta Class 3Q motor vehicle operator's license with acceptable driving record is required for a Municipal Worker III.
- Previous experience operating packers, single axle trucks, reclaimer, and other equipment used in road maintenance and repair is essential.
- The following valid safety certificates would be an asset: Standard First Aid certificate with CPR; WHMIS; Transportation of Dangerous Goods; Flagging.
- A management approved equivalent of education and experience may be considered.
