



Traffic Flagger

Cypress County has a seasonal opportunity for a Traffic Flagger until approximately October.

The Flagger works as part of a team involved in gravelling and oiling Cypress County's road infrastructure. Duties include controlling traffic flows to provide a safe worksite for the construction and maintenance crews at the various work sites and performing other related duties as required.

Our ideal candidate is dependable and reliable; physically able to stand and walk for long periods of time and work outdoors in all kinds of weather; able to work in a team environment, often without supervision; able to understand and apply safe work practices at all times; able to listen to and follow directions as well as communicate effectively with others. Compensation for the position is approximately \$22 per hour.

- Class 5 operator's license with acceptable driving record.
