We have an exciting opportunity for a Chief Assessor/Assessment Supervisor to join our team. The ideal candidate is accredited as either an Accredited Municipal Assessor of Alberta (AMAA) or through the Appraisal Institute of Canada (AACI) or with the International Association of Assessing Officers (CAE). In addition, he/she will have a Certificate in Real Property Assessment from the University of British Columbia and a Diploma in Urban Land Economics (DULE). A thorough knowledge of Provincial and Federal Legislation relating to the assessment of property is a requirement in this role combined with proficiency in CAMA systems, GIS, CAD and MS Office products. A valid Alberta Class 5 Operator's license is also required. A management approved equivalent combination of education and experience may be considered. Applicants not meeting qualifications of the Assessment Supervisor maybe considered for other roles in Assessment.
